New Climate Change Course Available

The USDA Forest Service Research and Development has released an interactive short course that presents current scientific knowledge on adapting to climate variability in wildland management. The “Adapting to Climate Change: A Short Course for Land Managers” course is available as a DVD or online at the Climate Change Resource Center (<http://www.fs.fed.us/ccrc>). This self-paced course provides current scientific and technical information and can help resource managers and decision makers to plan for future climate-influenced uncertainties. The three central themes are: climate variability and projections, ecological responses to climate variability, and management responses to climate variability. This course features 15 video lectures along with slide presentations, interactive quizzes, literature citations, and links to additional information.
