The Arbor Day Foundation’s “Tree Campus USA” program recognizes colleges and universities that work as a community to promote and maintain their urban forest on campus. In 2009, over seventy colleges and universities across the country earned recognition as a Tree Campus USA school. Standards to participate in the program include having a campus tree advisory committee; campus tree care plan; dedicated annual expenditures; an Arbor Day observance event; and a service learning project. Colleges and universities currently certified or undergoing certification also have the opportunity to apply for a tree planting event, hosted by Tree Campus USA.
